Last week we had Kaitlyn Majewski here who has done some great things in our Theatre department and the month before we had some of our athletes come and we are going to continue to honor their achievements. COMMITTEE REPORTS

Athletic – Jim Brown/Dan Goughnour/Steve Kondrosky – Mr. Kiss reported, in lieu of our meeting, we did discuss some agenda items. Spring sports recap, the Baseball team qualifies for the WPIAL playoffs for the first time in 21 years. The Board plans to recognize this team at the June 22 Board Meeting. This afternoon, senior pitcher and infielder Dustin Strong was selected as first team all-conference at the banquet in Monroeville. We just saw Kanye Thompson and Aaron Elm, we went through their accomplishments. Athletic Information for the 2022-2023 season: Fall sports physicals will be given in the Allied Health room at the High School on the following days, JV and Varsity on Thursday June 2nd, Fall sports on Saturday, June 4th. Any student having a physical examination dated after June 1, 2022 will be valid for the entire school year. The physical forms can be found in the high school office, the athletic office or electronically at www.mckasd.net under the athletics page under announcements. The male and female winners of the Charles Lickert Memorial Award will be announced on the district's

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Athletic Facebook page on Friday after 12pm. Preparations are being made to publicize Football and general Athletic season passes for next school year. Information will be available after August 1, 2022. The Khaleke Hudson Football Camp will be at the stadium on July 2, 2022. Khaleke is a second or third year player with the Washington Commanders, a recent football stand out player for us. More information will be made available to the public next month.

Buildings & Grounds – Steve Kondrosky/Jim Brown – Mr. Kondrosky reported, Mr. Balogh and myself met this afternoon. He gave me a list of his accomplishments from last month. All the building were transitioned from heat to AC. South Hall was switched over to AC on the 17th. Founders' Hall lighting was upgraded which was a major concern for practice. All the water fountains were replaced at McClure. Paving and patching was completed district wide. South Hall gym roof unit belts were changed out. Twin Rivers fuse's were changed out for the chilled water pumps. This is over now but they prepped the baseball and softball fields. They are prepping for Graduation with ramps, stage, carpet and promenade stations and pillars. South Hall uninvent was repaired, continue to take care of the grass and mulch the campus. The Neenie Campbell Gym bleachers were repaired.

Community Relations/Cultural Diversity – Diane Elias/Latoya Wright – Mrs. Wright reported, we met last week on 5/18. There is a new mentoring program that will be starting next school year called Bold Girls Mentoring. The program will be headed up by a few ladies within our district for girls. We have a mentoring program for boys but we don't have one for girls. There is a need for a program for girls, we have a problem understanding hair issues for black and brown girls for example. Sometimes you don't want to go to school because your hair is not put together. There are things that they are working on for students so they feel more comfortable coming to school.

Education/Legislation/Policy – Diane Elias/Dan Goughnour/Latoya Wright – Mrs. Wright reported, again we met last week on 5/18, We have a summer camp than begins June 7th, we have about 450 kids from K-8 that have signed up to be a part of this program. Last week me met about the launch that took place at Twin Rivers' School. I have heard some concern that we were changing the name of Twin Rivers, it is more of a mantra or tagline, United at Twin Rivers. With that launch, there will be a laundry room, food pantry and showers for the community to use and its all funded by DSGF. There will be a separate entrance and they will not be able to access the school due to security concerns.

Mr. Donato: Over the course of the time I've spent on the board, I have probably served with a number of these people up on the wall over the last five decades. Seldom have I been able to work closely with an individual that I call a friend and a consummate professional. No one that I knew in that particular position was as giving as Mark Holtzman. Seldom have I seen the kind of individuals that can put together a 12 to 14 hour day on behalf of kids here at McKeesport Area School District and we all know our troubles within the school district, did we all agree, of course not. His dad and I wanted to commit homicide when we were on the board together but this was an unusual graduate alumnus that come here spent his time here and came up through the ranks. I watched him from the moment he was hired and worked with Vida O'Neil in learning his craft and then came right along during those particular years and rose to the position which is the highest position in education within this school district. Are we the best educationally in Pennsylvania, of course no one can dispute that we are having our struggles. Did anybody do the little things better? In those buildings he was a presence. I have had the benefit of the interviewing scholarship kids in McKeesport Area School District over the last five or 6 Years, we were involved with scholarships and we get it we talk to those kids almost to a person they recognize former principal Mark Holtzman and our current resigning superintendent Mark Holtzman in a speak of his leadership and his eloquence. He's leaving an impact wherever he goes. This was a graduate that came back here and worked as hard as he could. He picking up kids at bus stops during Covid think about the obstacles that this superintendent had to overcome three years of Covid under the worst possible situation's, mass professional retirements and everything and he's holding it all together. I'm not sure that a lot of people that I have worked with in the past could perform under these circumstances. I wish Mark Holtzman and his family well. I think he's a quality individual who I am proud to call my friend and I wish well to of course Tia as well, his successor. They have been a heck of a team together and after July hopefully we will be making the right decision at that time. Thank you.
